We have had remarkable success in wastewater treatment and reduction of pollution in our Nation's waterways. We are now finding that our lakes, streams, and rivers still show impacts from excess nitrogen and phosphorus. This pollution is more subtle than the stories of the old days, before the Clean Water Act, but dealing with these non-point sources is the next step in restoring our waterways to pristine condition. In this Big Muddy presentation John Dunn will talk about the impacts of nutrients: Where do they come from? How do they get into streams? What are the environmental impacts here and downstream? What are we doing about it?
